Student Research Request Protocol

[Effective March 2014]

Services offered and price list:

ABGC will electronically distribute student research requests to ABGC Certified Genetic Counselors upon request. There is a limit of one email notification per month. However, multiple research requests will be sent in one blast email. If the request does not meet the deadline for the monthly email then it will be held over for the next month, if desired; this is based on a first received, first sent basis. There is no cost to this service.

ABGC will electronically distribute the requests from research@abgc.net. Note: ABGC Certified Genetic Counselors can opt-out of receiving these notices.

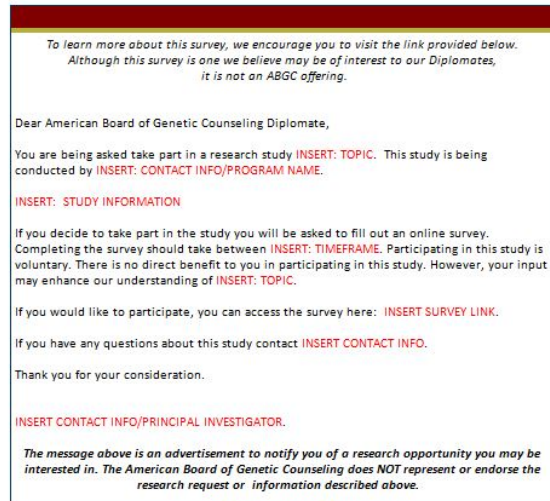
How to place an order:

(1) Compile the text of the request including: the name of the genetic counseling training program, school, title of the research project, purpose, brief explanation, name of requestor, and survey link and response due date.

(2) Email the text to the ABGC Executive Office at info@abgc.net.
